1. Eastleigh Lakeside Steam Railway

- ⇒ The miniature steam railway runs 1¼ miles to Monks Brook Halt (20 minutes)
- ⇒ Monks Brook Halt has a children's playground, lakes & picnic tables
- ⇒ The station building has a souvenir shop, café and a working model railway
- ⇒ Special events include a Day Out with Thomas the Tank Engine and Santa Specials

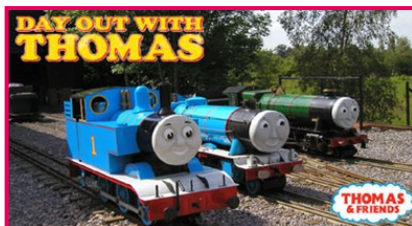

- ⇒ Special events include the Ghost Train experience
- ⇒ The Gardens are beautiful and fun to explore or enjoy a picnic, and there various events throughout the year including the Fun Trail
- ⇒ Hop on Hop off Buggy Service around the gardens available 1 adult & 1 child costs £4, the full ride is 30-40 minutes long

3. Royal Victoria Country Park Miniature Railway

- ⇒ The miniature railway runs for 1 mile through Royal Victoria Country Park
- ⇒ Special events throughout the year
- ⇒ 6 steam locomotives, 3 diesel, all with small carriages and low sides
- ⇒ Playground, café, gift shop and toilets located near to the station

4. Riverside Park Miniature Railway

- ⇒ Miniature steam and diesel trains run on a circuit through the park, from the Riverside Parkway Station –contact for ticket prices
- ⇒ The park has toilets, play grounds, cricket pitches, tennis courts, 18 hole pitch & putt, skate park, and pleasant riverside walks. It is also a good place to feed the swans and ducks.
- ⇒ Because of the riverside location of the track, children should be closely supervised as there is no fence between the park and the river -at low tide this is a very steep drop

5. Watercress Line Mid Hants Railway

- ⇒ Full sized steam locomotives run between Alresford and Alton
- ⇒ Free miniature railway at Ropley, every Saturday and Sunday from 11am until 4pm throughout the summer
- ⇒ Vintage bus rides between Alton station and Jane Austen's house in Chawton. The bus runs on the first Sunday of the month between May and October
- ⇒ Events include Santa specials, a day out with Thomas, and Murder Mystery nights on the dining trains
- ⇒ All of the scheduled services are capable of carrying up to six fixed wheelchairs, via ramps at of the stations. There is also a specially adapted carriage with a customised open space designed for wheelchair use around fixed tables

- ⇒ Disabled parking at both stations
- ⇒ Wheelchairs cannot access standard railway carriages due to narrow doorways but there are spaces for wheelchairs in certain carriages. Phone ahead to ensure this is in operation before your visit



6. Solent Sky Hall of Aviation

- ⇒ Aircraft museum with several real aeroplanes and helicopters.
- ⇒ A large flying boat you can go inside (access by steps, then ladder to enter cockpit)
- ⇒ A collection of aeronautical drawings, paintings, photographs, maps and models -displays are mainly visual, not interactive
- ⇒ All areas of the museum are wheelchair accessible except for aircraft flight decks
