- understand if you or other people are at risk of abuse. And do something about it.




We might not be able to give you a service or give you the right support or advice unless we have the right information.



We store personal information securely.

We try to make sure the information is right.

We only keep the information for as long as it is needed.



What does this information include?

- It includes personal details
- What support you need
- · What support or advice we have given you
- Which services you use



You can ask to see your information.

We will ask your permission to do this.

You can say no, but it may mean you don't get all the services you need.
