


# 2. Birdworld, Jenny Wren Farm & Underwater World

- ⇒ Over 2000 animals, from birds and mammals to tiny cockroaches and even snakes. The childfriendly farm is home to everything fluffy and furry from rabbits to donkeys. In the aquarium there are crocodiles, piranha and seahorses as well as lots of unusual marine species. You can learn about the residents, from how they live in the wild and here at the park to what they like for breakfast.



# 4. Bolderwood Deer Sanctuary

- ⇒ A purpose built viewing platform overlooking a large meadow area where a heard of fallow deer regularly gather
- ⇒ The viewing platform is close to the carpark and a large flat grassy lawn which is good for football, rounders, picnics and barbeques –there's also often an ice-cream van in the car park



# 10. Hawthorns Urban Wildlife Centre
