Impact Monitoring

We have produced a 10 question online (and paper) survey for parents carers to complete to give baseline data for monitoring the impact of the project. We have also sent this link out via our newsletter and on our social media platforms across Hampshire to ensure that we have a solid bank of baseline data.

Survey question topics:

- Frequency of travel
- Type of impairment
- Perception of safety when travelling
- Ease of getting help
- Staff helpfulness
- Booking assistance
- Behaviour/attitude of other passengers
- Visiting unknown destinations
- Ease of travelling by train
- Perceived barriers to travelling by train

We have also produced an easy read questionnaire for young people to complete using emojis to enable us to measure any changes in their levels of enjoyment, confidence, self-esteem and independence when travelling to destinations by train.

December 2020 Baseline Questionnaire results to date

The results to date, in summary, are:

- Parents/carers rarely travel by train with the child/young person they care for.
- They generally feel safe when travelling by rail though 19% felt quite unsafe.
- 67% parent/carers needed to ask rail staff for help or information. 20% couldn't find anyone to ask.
- 33% parent/carers found staff were not helpful "It's very variable depending on the train company and the station. For example Southampton central are generally lovely. Waterloo staff are awful."
- Only 40% parent/carers booked assistance but have not always had a positive experience. One person did not know the service was available. "Assistance can be inconsistent so it feels like playing roulette as to if it's easy to get on and off"
- Most parent/carers found that the behaviour of other passengers worried them or made them feel uncomfortable to some extent (67%).
- Very few parent/carers had the confidence to travel to a destination they had not visited before due to a lack of information.
- Half of the parent/carers who responded found travelling by rail difficult.

• Parent/carers perceived barriers to rail travel are predominantly around lack of assistance (87%), they also see accessibility and facilities at stations and on the train as a barrier (80%). A lack of information and timetable disruptions were also significant barriers (80%).

We will also ensure this survey is completed by families who are testing the rail routes and resources.
