Runner Terms and Conditions

By applying for one of The Rose Road Association's limited TCS London Marathon places, you accept and agree to abide by the terms and conditions below. These terms are a fundraising agreement between you and The Rose Road Association.

The Rose Road Association has the right to change or update the terms and conditions at its discretion and participants are invited to regularly check this page for updates.

1. You confirm that your general health and fitness is good (we recommend checking with a doctor if you are unsure) and understand that the event is not organised by The Rose Road Association but by TCS London Marathon events and therefore we shall have no liability for any injury, damage or loss suffered by you when taking part in or in connection with the event.
2. You understand that The Rose Road Association has a limited number of places for the TCS London Marathon 2027 and therefore there are no guarantees that your application will be successful, your application will be reviewed and we reserve the right to refuse any application at our absolute discretion without providing reason.
3. You understand that if you are successful in securing a place with Rose Road, you will also need to agree to TCS London Marathon Events own [terms and conditions and event rules](#).
4. You understand that if successful in securing a place with Rose Road for the TCS London Marathon 2027 you must pay the £50 non-refundable and non-transferrable registration fee within two weeks of the offer date. If we don't receive payment by this date, we reserve the right to cancel your place and offer it to someone else.
5. You understand that your registration data (namely name and email address) will be shared with the TCS London Marathon and their entry platform; Lets Do This, in order to register your official event place. This will be processed in accordance with their [privacy policies](#).



6. You understand that you will be required to also register with London Marathon Events and failure to complete this by the applicable deadline will mean you will not be able to take part in the event and will not be entitled to a refund.
7. By paying your £50 registration fee you agree to fundraise a minimum of £2,500 (excluding registration fee, gift aid and match funding), and understand that The Rose Road Association has the right to withdraw your place at any time if we consider that you are not committed to raising the minimum target or if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions set out in this document.
8. You understand that all charity place runners are required to raise a minimum of 80% of their fundraising target 6 weeks before race day.
9. By accepting your place, you agree that all monies raised in connection with the TCS London Marathon 2027 both online and offline, must be paid to The Rose Road Association no later than 4 weeks after race day.
10. You will only use lawful means to fundraise and will not do anything that harms or is likely to harm The Rose Road Associations reputation, complying with the [fundraising regulator](#). You understand that if you withdraw from the event any monies raised will not be refunded and will be treated as a donation.
11. You understand that all charity place deferrals are at The Rose Road Associations absolute discretion and are not guaranteed.
12. Any photos, video, audio or quotes taken by The Rose Road Association on race day may be used to inspire future fundraisers and promote events, if you don't want the media listed above to be used in this way, please let us know.
